Here's your weekly update on what our teams have been working on in relation to our Back To School planning.

- The LFS/LFH commitment form is now closed. As a reminder, the default option for any families who did not respond is Learn From School. Principals and secretaries will be in touch in the event that there was a problem with your form. If you have changed your mind regarding your LFS/LFH choice, please reach out to your school principal IMMEDIATELY.
- Here are the updates we have to share:
- Per the recommendations of the City of Racine Health Department, when feasible all students will be screened for temperature upon entry. All families are still expected to screen for temperature and signs of infectious illness on a daily basis. School staff will screen students who appear symptomatic. Teachers who observe ill students will send them to the main office.
- As a reminder, here is the link to <u>at-home screening</u>.
- Don't forget to apply for free/reduced lunch.
- In addition to the regular <u>supply lists</u>, don't forget to purchase cloth masks and a reusable water bottle for any LFS students. Each LFS student and all faculty/staff will be provided one cloth mask.
- It is important to sanitize your own technology, including phones and tablets. Here are some tips!

We continue to answer questions and add to our FAQ; when updates are made we will communicate them. You will continue to receive weekly communication on the return to school and what promises to be an extraordinary year!
