Subject: Annual Letter of Availability of Asbestos Management Plan

Siena Catholic Schools of Racine (Saint Catherine's High School) has been inspected for asbestos-containing building materials by a State Certified Asbestos Inspector. A written management plan including the inspection report has been submitted to the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and reviewed for compliance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR Part 763 effective December 1987.

The management plan describing the locations and conditions of known and assumed asbestos-containing building materials is available at the school administrative office for anyone to review. If anyone requests a copy of the report, we will need the request in writing and a fee for the labor and duplication.

Planned response actions have been performed in the past school year by an asbestos certified license contractor (Robinson Brothers).

The EPA required three year re-inspection and 6 month periodic surveillances will be conducted by a State Certified Asbestos Inspector from AP Environmental, Inc.
