Nestled near the family-friendly suburb of Caledonia, St. Rita School is truly mission-driven: our identity as a Catholic school is woven into every aspect of school life and each child's personal relationship with Jesus is forefront. We foster this relationship with daily religion class, daily prayer, weekly Mass, and seasonal religious activities. EDUCATING OUR STUDENTS

- FAITH As a school, we start and end each day with prayer and attend Mass weekly. Students participate in daily religion classes. Faith formation practices include adoration, rosary, and retreats.
- EXTRACURRICULARS Opportunities to learn new skills and explore interests include volleyball, cross country, basketball, track, curling, scholastic competitions, Tablesetters Service Club, English Fest, Battle of the Books, STEM Club, Multicultural Club, Yearbook, Drama Club, Study Club, and Math Club.
- STAFF Our staff is led by principal Jennifer Jeffers, a two-time
 National Board Certified educator, WATG Gifted Educator of the
 Year, and Herb Kohl Fellowship recipient. Our teachers hold
 Wisconsin teaching licenses and Archdiocese of Milwaukee
 religious education certification. A majority of the staff have
 been a part of the school for multiple years, providing stability,
 consistency, expertise, and experience.

Partnering With Our Community


